



### HOW TO UPDATE YOUR MAILING ADDRESS WITH EL PASO COUNTY TAX ASSESSOR for Residential Property

It is necessary for the local tax assessor to have an updated mailing address for homeowners because they rely on sending important tax-related documents to homeowners, including property tax bills, assessment notices, and other important legal notices. If the homeowner does not receive these notices or bills, they may be subject to penalties or missed deadlines. In addition, an outdated mailing address can lead to confusion and delays in the communication between the homeowner and the tax assessor, which can ultimately result in issues with property taxes and assessments.
